
Building a house is unlike any other project you'll ever be a part of. Because between those four walls lives your family, your life.

1. Define the Basics

When deciding to start the home building process, the first thing you'll want to do is define your project, starting with the basics. This will be helpful when beginning to get help from your realtor/architect/builder/etc.


- Number of bedrooms
- Number of bathrooms
- Basic floor plan
- Special/specific rooms desired
- Desired total square footage
- Desired lot size



2. Establish a Budget

Then you'll next want to set your total budget for this project. This should include:

- Lot purchase
- Total construction and labor costs
- Interior finishes, cabinetry, etc.
- Well/septic if necessary



3. Solidify Your Style

After you've done those maybe-not-so-enjoyable things, treat yourself to some fun and search on Pinterest.com or Houzz.com and start to solidify your style. Are you more:

Draw It



After you've identified the basics for your home and identified a lot that you plan to build on, the next step is to create your home's floor plan.

1. Rough Floor Plan

Initially you'll want to draw a rough sketch yourself, and may choose to utilize a sample or template plan that has the basics you're looking for included. Good places to find plans are:

- Pinterest.com
- Houzz.com
- HousePlans.com and HomePlans.com



2. Architectural Plans

We'll then take your rough floor plan and work with an architect to create structural blue prints that include important information about electrical, plumbing, HVAC, etc. Then:

- You'll review the architectural plans and make an adjustments
- The approved plans will be used to create a cost estimate for the project


1. Select Your Finishes


2. Final Sign Off

The Home Building Process Checklist


- Pull permit
- Dig hole
- Footings/foundation/flat concrete
- Framing
- Rough plumbing, electrical and HVAC installed
- Insulation
- Begin exterior finishes:
 - Roof
 - Soffit/fascia/gutters
 - Siding
 - Masonry
- Drywall + paint
- Interior finishes:
 - Doors/trim/cabinetry installed
 - Hard surface flooring + countertops installed
 - Carpet, mirrors, shower doors, cabinet pulls, etc.
- Pour driveway + sidewalks
- Rough grade property
- Final walk through
- Final Inspection

This entire process usually takes 6-12 months dependent on many factors. We'll keep you up-to-date and encourage you to stop and see the progress on your Dream Home! - The Dobish Construction Crew
